## **BUSINESS REPRESENTATION DEFINITIONS**

The following definitions are provided for information purposes only by Nammo Talley, Inc.. All information should be verified using the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), Code of Federal Regulation (CFR), United States Code (U.S.C.), and/or website referenced herein.

**LARGE BUSINESS:** A domestic firm that does not meet the small business size standards per 13 CFR Part 121. Businesses should contact the US Small Business Administration (SBA) or [www.sba.gov](http://www.sba.gov) to determine appropriate North American Industry Classification (NAICS) codes and size standard. The threshold for number of employees and revenue vary depending upon the product or service being offered.

**FOREIGN-OWNED BUSINESS:** A business organized or existing under the laws of a country other than the United States. The United States means the 50 states and the District of Columbia, U.S. territories and possessions, Puerto Rico, the Northern Mariana Islands and any other place subject to U.S. jurisdiction, but does not include leased bases.

**SMALL BUSINESS:** A concern, including its affiliates, that is independently owned and operated and qualified as a small business under the criteria and size standards in 13 CFR Part 121. Businesses should contact the U.S. Small Business Administration or [www.sba.gov](http://www.sba.gov) to determine appropriate North American Industry Classification (NAICS) codes and size standard. The threshold for number of employees and revenue vary depending upon the product or service being offered.

**WOMAN-OWNED SMALL BUSINESS:** A small business which is: 1) at least 51% owned by one or more women, or, in the case of any publicly owned business, at least 51% of the stock of which is owned by one or more women; and 2) whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more women.

**VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS:** A small business which is: 1) at least 51% owned by one or more veterans (as defined in U.S.C. 101(2)) or, in the case of any publicly owned business, at least 51% of the stock of which is owned by one or more veterans; and 2) whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more veterans.

**SERVICE-DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED SMALL BUSINESS:** A small business which is: 1) at least 51% owned by one or more service-disabled veterans or, in the case of any publicly owned business, at least 51% of the stock of which is owned by one or more service-disabled veterans; and 2) whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more service-disabled veterans or, in the case of a service-disabled veteran with a permanent and severe disability, the spouse or permanent caregiver of such veteran.

**SMALL DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS (Including Certified "8(a)" Businesses):** A small business that represents itself as disadvantaged in accordance with 13 CFR 124. The business must be at least 51% owned and controlled by a socially and economically disadvantaged individual or individuals. African Americans, Hispanic Americans, Asian Pacific Americans, Subcontinent Asian Americans, and Native Americans are presumed to qualify. Other individuals can qualify if they show by a "preponderance of the evidence" that they are disadvantaged. All individuals must have a net worth of less than \$750,000, excluding the equity of the business and primary residence. "Certified" Small Disadvantaged Businesses are certified by the Small Business Administration (SBA). Contact [www.sba.com](http://www.sba.com) for more information.

**HUB ZONE SMALL BUSINESS:** A small business 1) owned and controlled at least 51% by U.S. citizens, or a Community Development Corporation, or an agricultural cooperative, or an Indian tribe; 2) with its principal office located within a 'Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) Zone'; and 3) at least 35% of its employees residing in a HUBZone. A HUBZone small business must be on the List of Certified HUBZone Small Business Concerns maintained by the SBA at [www.sba.gov/hubzone](http://www.sba.gov/hubzone).

**HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGE UNIVERSITY (HBCU):** An institution determined by the Secretary of Education to meet the requirements of 34 CFR 608.2. For the Department of Defense (DoD), NASA, and the Coast Guard, the term also includes any nonprofit research institution that was an integral part of such a college or university before 11/14/86.

**MINORITY INSTITUTION:** An institution of higher education meeting the requirements of Section 1046(3) of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1135d-5(3)) which, for the purposes of this clause, includes a Hispanic-serving institution of higher education as defined in Section 316(b)(1) of the Act (20 U.S.C. 1059c(b)(1)).
