GENERAL

1. Packing list must accompany each shipment.
2. Whenever practical, consolidate multi-containers in one box. Consolidate all shipments to be forwarded in one day and consign on one collect bill of lading.
3. All material must be described on shipping documents in accordance with the applicable classification or tariff.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: *In order to provide the proper transportation and services, the following instructions must be followed:*

1. Nammo Talley Planning, Inventory & Logistics Department will be contacted for transportation instructions **prior** to the shipment of **all 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3** Explosives in the following manner:
 - a. Fill out [TDS-2702](#) found on the Supplier Connection website;
 - b. Provide the hazard class and division, proper shipping name and UN#, pieces weight, and dimensions of the shipment; and
 - c. Email the completed form to shipping@nammotalley.com
2. For shipments of HAZARDOUS MATERIALS, all containers must be properly classified, described, packaged, marked, and labeled and in proper condition for transportation in accordance with all current transportation regulations (CFR 49, IATA, or IMDG).
 - a. Nammo Talley Planning, Inventory & Logistics Department will be contacted for routing instructions of all Truckload and Volume Shipments. The shipper is to provide the pieces, weight, and dimensions of the shipment on TDS-2702 and email to shipping@nammotalley.com. If there is any question as to type of shipment (i.e., LTL or TL) contact the Nammo Talley Planning, Inventory & Logistics Department for clarification at 480-898-2450 or shipping@nammotalley.com

LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Shipments of 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, and quantities of 1.4 Explosives with N.E.W. over 1,000 pounds **must be** blocked and braced to prevent movement during transportation.
2. Truckload or volume Shipments must be loaded to facilitate offloading by forklift or pallet jack. Two-way entry pallets must be loaded so that pallet entry openings are facing the tail of the trailer.
3. Truckload or Volume Shipments must be secured within the trailer to minimize shifting and movement during transit. This will be accomplished by blocking and bracing and/or use of cargo rails.
4. If pallets are stacked, the load must be stable. Pallets must be able to be removed by forklift.
